Assembly Point – Ballyclare Secondary School opposite Ballyclare Presbyterian Church on the Doagh Road.

Each Company and Junior Section will parade together. Each Company must report to the Adjutant with the enclosed slip indicating the number of Boys and Officers on parade. Any money for collections should be placed in an envelope prior to the parade and an NCO appointed to present the offering in church

- 2.55 1st Bugle call** Companies should fall-in in the order shown overleaf
- 3.00 2nd Bugle call** Colours will be marched on and the parade will then move off.
- 3.20 Arrival in church.** Companies will march up the side of the church and halt. The Colours will be marched off and the parade will proceed by company into church.
- 3.30** There will be a special order of service. The NCO appointed to present the collection should remain in the vestibule to receive instructions.
- 4.30** The Battalion will reform in parade order at the side of the church. The Saluting base will be in the Town Square opposite Woodside's shop. The salute will be taken by the Battalion President, Mr. Drew Buchanan M.B.E and the Battalion Chaplain, Rev. C.McClure.

Parade Route

Leave the school by the lower gateway, turning left onto Mill Road, then left onto Main Street, following the Square and turn left onto Doagh Road to church. The return route will be the reverse. **In the case of inclement weather the C.O. and the Adjutant will decide if the parade to the church will take place.** We will always parade from the church back to the assembly point as agreed at the Company Section Council.

Companies are asked to ensure, that marching is of the highest standard, that an Officer is appointed to march on the outside (traffic side) of each company and that reverence is maintained throughout the service.

Please ensure that all Boys have rain protection clothing with them.
