Senior 4 A Side Church Hall League

- Each team must nominate a panel of no more than 8 players before the match starts on the team sheet. Rolling subs are allowed.
- In order to maintain accurate records, **results sheets should be returned** to Neil McAllister immediately after each match with the **goal scorers** from each team detailed. Also, phone results through to Neil McAllister after match. Your assistance in this would be greatly appreciated.
- Normal indoor nets (size will vary depending on facilities of company)
- Duration of play – 12 minutes each way.
- The ball may **NOT** be played above head height.
- Goalkeepers should have a marked out area in which they must stay and no other player may enter.
- No outfield players allowed *to gain an advantage* by entering the semi circle around goal.
 - a. Defending player entering the semi circle – penalty from agreed spot
 - b. Attacking team entering semi circle – keeper's ball
- Sliding tackles are **NOT** allowed.
- The opposition must be a minimum of 1 metre from any free kick. (Failure to move back 1 metre from ball will result in the referee moving the ball 1 metre forward)
- A goal cannot be scored direct from the kick-off.
- No offside rule.
- All free kicks, apart from over head height, are direct and can be taken as quickly as the attacking team desires
- If a free kick is committed closer than 1 metre from the semi circle the ball will be placed 1metre from the semi circle so as the defender does not have to defend inside the semi circle
- A "**2 minute Sin Bin**" will operate for misconduct unless the referee deems the foul serious enough to warrant sending off.
- After a goal is scored the team which conceded the goal will kick off from the centre spot
- Scoring system:
 - a. 3 points for a win
 - b. 2 points for a draw
